

Physical Education

The school continues to provide the children with different opportunities to develop their physical abilities by trying various sports and competitions including Sports Day/National Sports and Horse Riding for the Disabled, Gymnastics, 'Anglesey Outdoors', specific training e.g. Hockey, Tennis and Rugby, basketball competitions, swimming, cross-country running, bowling and botcha.

Grants

The purpose of the Pupil Development Grant is to improve outcomes for learners from low income families who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM). In 2019-20, Canolfan Addysg y Bont received a Pupil Development Grant allocation of £31,050 and £700 in relation to the Early Years Pupil Development Grant. We have a comprehensive plan to promote progress and to alleviate obstacles to learning for students who are eligible for these funds.

The grant was used to employ a full time teacher from March 19 to August 19, a part time teacher from September 19 to March 20 and a member of staff and goods to develop communication HUB.

A grant of £22,473 was received in relation to an Education Improvement Grant and it was mainly used to fund training for the 'Communication Friendly School' accreditation, including training all members of staff in elements of the following, Elklan, Makaton and PECS. Some of the grant was used to create and develop a 'Communication HUB' from new.

Steps taken to strengthen community engagement

The Body continues in its efforts to maintain the engagement between the school and the local community, in order to enable pupils to learn to behave and interact satisfactorily in different situations. The activities include the following:

A firm response to the Covid agenda, including ensuring a Care Centre for the Easter and Whitsun holidays. Bangor University Professional Development Networks.
